ICD-10-CM codes (2016 to 2017): Dx T36-T50; a 5th/6th character of 2-intentional self-harm; a 7th character of A-initial encounter, D-subsequent encounter, or missing.

ICD-9-CM codes (2008 to 2014): Ecode E950.0-E950.5 (Self-Inflicted)

Notes: In 2016, a new data file structure was provided which included additional diagnosis code fields. It is unclear how this impacts trend data. Please interpret trends with caution.
